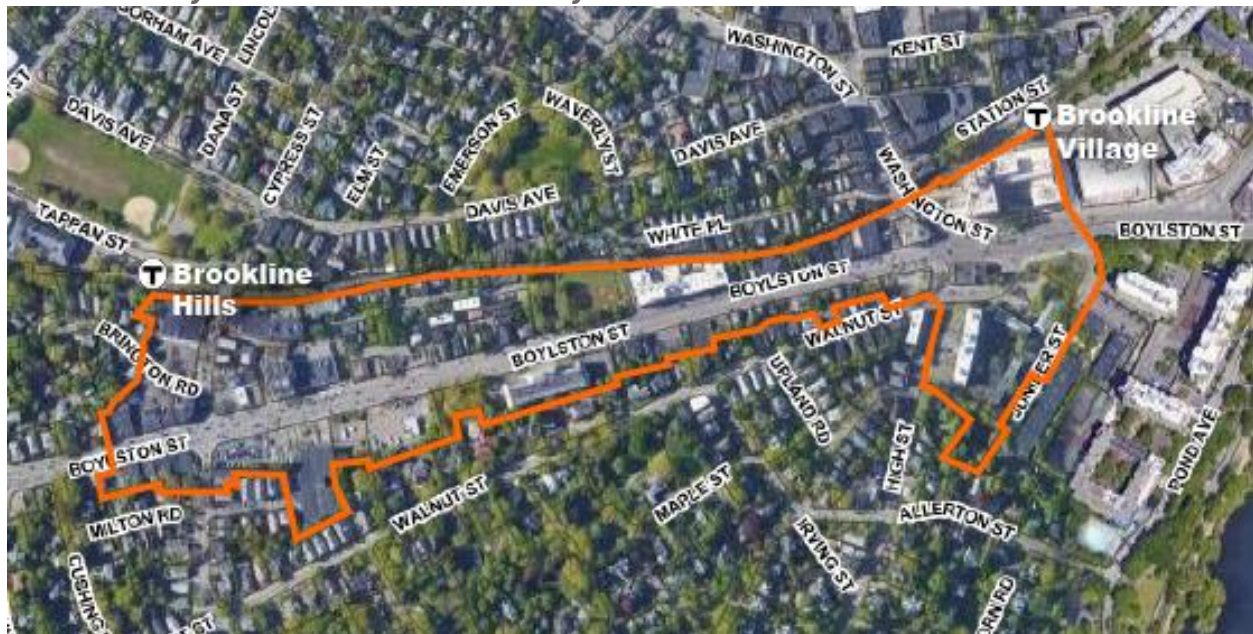

On July 9, 2019, the Select Board voted to create the Boylston Street Corridor Study Committee to focus on development in the area immediately surrounding Boylston Street (State Route 9), from Brington Road to Brookline Village at High Street (including immediately adjacent areas where appropriate). This Study Committee was tasked with comprehensively examining housing

stock preservation, area redevelopment, and infrastructure improvement opportunities that can help transform the Boylston Corridor into a place defined by walkability, multi-modal transportation, and contextually appropriate urban design.
