**Please join us at Murphy Playground on either date listed above to discuss the renovation of the park and share your ideas with the project Landscape Architect! We will be set-up on the open lawn space. Improvements to Murphy Playground will include:**

- Universal access within the park;
- Treatment of the park's perimeter and entries to address issues of accessibility;
- Redesign of the playground spaces and water play, including play equipment for all ages and resilient safety surfacing;
- Site furniture and destinations for seating and picnicking throughout the park;
- New plantings;
- Discussion of hardcourt play space;
- Renovation of open lawn; and,
- Grading work and drainage enhancements to direct runoff appropriately

**At these on-site meetings, we will share the design concepts that were presented at our last virtual public meeting. We would love to hear your thoughts so that we may revise the proposed designs to best meet the needs of the community and all park users.**
