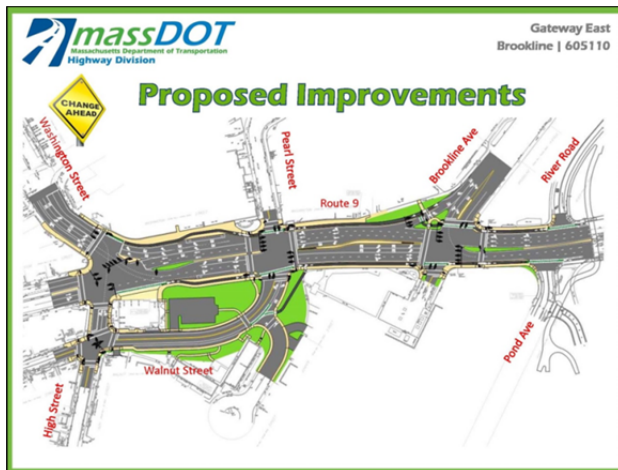

NIGHT PAVING RAIN DELAY
Gateway East Transportation Improvements
NOW RE-SCHEDULED NIGHTS: WED, OCT 14 – FRI, OCT 16

Dear Brookline Resident, Proprietor or Institution,

MDR Construction Co., Inc., under contract with MassDOT Highway for the Gateway East roadway reconstruction project, and their Paving Sub-Contractor, Don Martin Corp, are scheduled to start Night Work this coming WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 14, 2020, at 7:00PM for the specified tasks of final roadway paving operations (an anticipated 3-night duration) and pavement markings installations (a projected 5-night duration), both susceptible to wet or cold weather delays. ***Proposed night paving and markings areas are at the roadways shaded gray below, along Route 9:***



NIGHT WORK LOGISTICS

Night work hours will be 7:00PM - 5:00AM, a 10-hour nightly operation, weeknights only (Sun-Thur). In terms of night schedule, the Contractor plans to pave Washington St (Rt9) Eastbound Wed, Oct 14; Washington St (Rt9) Westbound Thur, Oct 15; and Walnut St extension, Juniper St, and High St Fri, Oct 16. Pavement markings will immediately follow and continue the next week, nights of Oct 18-22.

EXEMPTION PERMIT TO NOISE BY-LAW

The Town of Brookline's Select Board granted MDR Construction an exemption to the Noise Control By-Law at their weekly meeting this past Tuesday, October 6, 2020, after evaluation, questions and comments. The permit is limited to weekday nights during a 3-week window: Oct 12- Nov 2, 2020, to allow for weather or equipment issues. All efforts will be undertaken by the contractors to reduce noise from trucking and paving equipment.
