## ROADWAY PAVING NOTICE

Dear Abutting Residents:

**Paving on Clinton Road has been rescheduled. Work will start on Wednesday, May 12<sup>th</sup>, weather permitting.** Work will begin at 7:00 AM. Sections of Clinton Road will be temporary closed during the paving.

Brookline Police officers will be on site to detour and assist vehicle and pedestrian traffic.

There will be **no on street parking along this section of Clinton Road between 7:00 AM and 5 PM.**

**Driveway access will be restricted during the paving. Residents should remove their vehicles prior to 7:00 AM if they need to use their vehicle during this time.**

**Curbside parking will be prohibited** within active work zones, but will re-open after 5 PM,

This notice can be used as a temporary parking permit for residents during working hours. To use this as a parking permit, residents must place this notice beneath the driver side windshield of the car and park on an abutting street or section of Babcock not under construction.
