Do you need to earn a little extra income each month to supplement your social security payments and want to learn new employment skills? If so, the JOBS program is for you!

For the past ten years, the Town of Brookline with funding from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program has provided funding to low income seniors for job training leading to part time employment at the Senior Center.

**IN ORDER TO QUALIFY, YOU MUST MEET THESE INCOME GUIDELINES:**

**Singles:**

Income must be less than \$47,150/year

**Couples:**

Income must be less than \$53,900/year
