

Community Partnership Committee Banner Program

In cooperation with the Brookline Arts Commission the 2022 US Open Community Partnership Committee has undertaken a program to 'dress up' the Town a bit with banners to be displayed on the Town's street light poles around the days of the Open. Through the efforts of The Arts Commission submissions were solicited for a juried design competition to find a meritorious entry, celebrating the Open particularly in a way that champions the theme of diversity. Over 35 entries were received from Brookline artists of a wide range of ages and backgrounds. Rather than a single winner, four winners were chosen; one first place winner and three runners-up. The first-place winning artist was Penny Scheerer who will receive \$1,000. The three runners-up, Aaron Friedland, Jin Suk and Sophia Loiurio (a fourth grader!) will receive \$500 each. The banners are currently being printed and should be decorating street light poles by May 15.
